What is TYE?

TiE Young Entrepreneurs (TYE) is TiE Global' s International Youth Program, aimed towards the future generation of entrepreneurs. TYE focuses on teaching entrepreneurship to young people and helping them discover the rewards and challenges of becoming an entrepreneur.

- It's a business education program, geared toward inspiring young students to be entrepreneurs through mentor-based workshops, taught by established industry leaders, who foster innovation, leadership skills, creativity and self-confidence.
- It offers a business plan competition with cash prizes at the regional level, which is the culmination of the student education program.
- Students who win their local business plan competition have an opportunity to win a GRAND PRIZE of \$10,000 in the Global Competition.
